He (peace and prayers be upon Him) said: If any of you say, when he comes to a woman of his household: "Oh Allah! turn Satan away from me and turn Satan away from the favour you have granted us", and if there is a child between the two of them, then Satan will not harm it. And when you are close to ejaculating, say to yourself without moving your lips "Praise be to Allah who has created a human being from fluid and has made him kinship by blood and marriage" [Al-furqan 54]. The Prophet (SAW), whenever He faced the enemy, before combating them, would say: "Oh Allah! Indeed we are your servants and they are your servants; our forelocks and their forelocks [i.e. control over us and them] are in your hand; oh Allah! Subdue them and grant us victory over them." From this it is evident that every warrior ought to emulate the Messenger of Allah (SAW) in issuing the call to people [du'a] at the time of fighting. And whenever the Muslims faced the Idolaters, if it was a group which had not been made aware of Islam, they were not to fight them until giving the du'a to them. If they had already been made aware of Islam, but did not know that we take

jizya from them, then we were not to fight them until giving the du'a to them regarding giving jizya; this is what the Messenger of Allah (SAW) ordered the commanders of the army, and was the last thing by which fighting could be avoided.

And when He saw where he was, He said: What is with you, Abu Ayub? He said: Oh Messenger of Allah, I feared for you with this woman, a woman who you killed her father and her husband and her people, and she has come recently from unbelief. So I feared for you with her. And some people alleged that the Messenger of Allah (SAW) said: "Oh Allah! guard Abu Ayub just as he spent the night guarding me."

He did not stop crying out to his Lord, with his hands stretched out, facing the Qibla, until his garment fell off his shoulders. And Abu Bakr grabbed his garment and threw it back on his shoulders, then hung onto him from behind, and said: Oh Prophet of Allah! You've implored your Lord enough; surely He will accomplish for you what He has promised. Then Allah sent down: { You all appeal to your Lord for help, and He answered you: "I will support you with a thousand angels coming one after the other" \{\} . And Allah supported them with the angels.

Then he proceeded ahead and was killed. And no one recognized him until his sister recognized him by a birthmark or by his fingertips. There were eighty-something stabs, strikes, and arrow pierces on him.
